SET TARGETS & BE PERSISTENT

- Meet with teachers or counselors to review goals
- Coordinate action plan with caregiver and caseworker
- Do research and homework for ARDs
- Become a Surrogate Parent

MINIMIZE THE NUMBER OF MOVES

- Advocate to keep school of origin
- Help arrange for transportation
- Ask for postponement, if possible
- If a move is necessary, be mindful of testing dates

ADVOCATE FOR EDUCATIONAL NEEDS & GOALS

- Monitor progress ask for examples
- Meet with school personnel
- Attend ARD and IEP meetings if applicable
- Report needs in court reports
- Review school records and education portfolio
- Request tutoring and help locate services
- Avoid labels assigned to the child
- Protect child's confidentiality
- ② Discuss social skills and peer relationships
- Explore extracurricular activities
- Encourage trauma lens in regards to behavior
